


1. Wagga Excursion


Our end of term two reward excursion to the Riverina Environmental Centre and Vortex was a great day.

Welcome back for Term 3 everyone! In the Gold Room, we have begun our new Literacy learning unit which is all about poetry! Students will continue to learn and explore how authors use imagery, symbol and connotation in poetry and how figurative language can influence meaning.

We have been focussing on learning all about Onomatopoeia, Metaphors and Alliteration and Personification, while reading the amazing book of poetry *"It's The Sound Of The Thing"* by Maxine Beneba Clarke.

> In Maths, we have been focussing on learning all about place value and partitioning and identifying the relationships between addition and subtraction. This unit develops the big idea that the number system extends infinitely to very large and very small numbers.
